

Winter Adventure Lapland

with Huskies, Reindeers and Snowmobiles
7 days/6 nights

Every week between 29th November 2015 and 18th April 2016



Come and enjoy the fascinating beauty of the Lapp nature on three different tours. During the reindeer safari you will experience a still existing ancient habitat. With the snowmobile you will discover the beauty of the fells and forests. One day you will have for your own interests; perhaps you would like to go skiing, have a walk, or go on a snow-shoe tour or just have a day to relax, and enjoy the amazing winter wonderland. Finally you will make a 2-day dog-sled safari into the wilderness where you can enjoy the silence and beauty of the nature and learn new skills in fire making for the cabin and sauna and look after the feeding of your team of dogs.

Day 1

Transfer from Kittilä to the husky base. Get together with the safari group and information about the programme for the week. Dinner and overnight in cosy double rooms with shower/wc.

Day 2

Today you will visit a traditional 100 year old reindeer farm. You will be taught about a reindeer's life which will give you information about reindeer breeding habits, and the role that reindeer play in the Lapp culture. You will also see a small exhibition of old traditional tools and things on the premises. Coffee will be served around an open fire in a typical Lapp tent. After the coffee you will be transferred to the reindeer herders, who will tell about the reindeer and reindeer husbandry.

They will show you how to catch the reindeer with the Lappish lasso, and you can practise it yourself. After you have helped the reindeer herders to harness the reindeer you start the 7km safari through the forest with one or two persons in the sledge. Lunch will be served around an open fire during the safari. In the afternoon return to the husky base. Sauna, dinner and overnight.

Day 3

Our experienced guides will show you how to drive the snowmobile and you will spend the day driving through the Fell scenery and over the frozen lakes. Lunch by an open fire in the wilderness. 2 people per snowmobile. Duration of the excursion approximately 5 hours, the distance driven 60 to 80km. Sauna, dinner and overnight at husky base.



Day 4

This day is free for your own activities. You can go cross-country skiing or downhill skiing is possible on the nearby Olos-Fell. Or what about a snow-shoe tour or maybe you would just like to relax. All meals and overnight at husky base.



Day 5

After breakfast you pack your equipment and get acquainted with the happy huskies. You will be taught how to handle the sled and then you leave for the two day safari. Lunch by an open fire en route. Everybody drives their own dog team of 4-5 dogs. You will drive about 25 km to a wilderness cabin with shared facilities where you will take care of feeding your dogs, have sauna, dinner and stay overnight in cabin.

Day 6

Today you will cover a distance of around 25km to 30km. Lunch by campfire en-route. In the afternoon you will return to the holiday centre. After having a relaxing sauna you will have a farewell dinner with Lapp specialities. Overnight at husky base.

Day 7

Breakfast and transfer to Kittilä airport with lots of happy memories.

Services included:

Transfers, 5 overnights in cosy double rooms with shower/wc at the husky base, 1 night in a wilderness hut, full board (from dinner on day 1 until breakfast on day 7), complete equipment for the whole stay (Thermo-overalls, socks, mittens, boots, warm hat, sleeping bag), one day reindeer programme, 2-day husky safari (everybody drives own husky team with 4-5 huskies), a qualified guide, 1 snowmobile for 2 persons for the snowmobile tour, cross-country skiing equipment or snow shoes for one day, insurance for the snowmobile with own liability of max EUR 600. **Please note that a valid driving licence is required for driving a snowmobile!**



Supplementary nights:

£75 / person in cosy double room with half board (sharing)
£115 / person in cosy single room with half board
£75 / person 3rd adult sharing room

Children: This Winter Activity week is only suitable for those aged 18 years and above. We recommend **Winter Fun** for children aged 5 years and above.
