

## Mountain Wilderness Basecamp trip - 7 night trip



Based in the beautiful region of Peuraure, south of Sarak National Park, a 1.5 hour drive from the kennel base and then a 16km snowmobile ride into the beautiful scenic wilderness of Lapland. (It is possible sometimes to start from kennels taking sleds and dogs with car and drive up the valley and then it's around 30 to 40km to cabin with dogs).



The cabin is totally self-contained with a double bedroom and twin bedroom sleeping up to 4 people. You have your own wood fired sauna and warm outside toilet. The cabin will be your base for the next 5 nights.



Pickup is from Luleå Airport on an evening flight and take you 2 hours to the kennels - you then get the chance for an early night ready for the beginning of your adventure the next morning.





The next day we depart by car then snowmobile to Peuraure, the same on the return journey. The days involve preparing Huskies for travel, feeding them and being out travelling across the scenic landscape. We stop for coffees and lunch by a fire, you can drive your own team of huskies or leisurely enjoy the ride as a passenger. We usually travel around 20-30km per day. We follow trails around the area from forest to high mountains. Evenings will involve taking a sauna, relaxing and dining with local menu. If you would like a day of snowmobiling then this can also be arranged. We also ice fish and build igloos.
